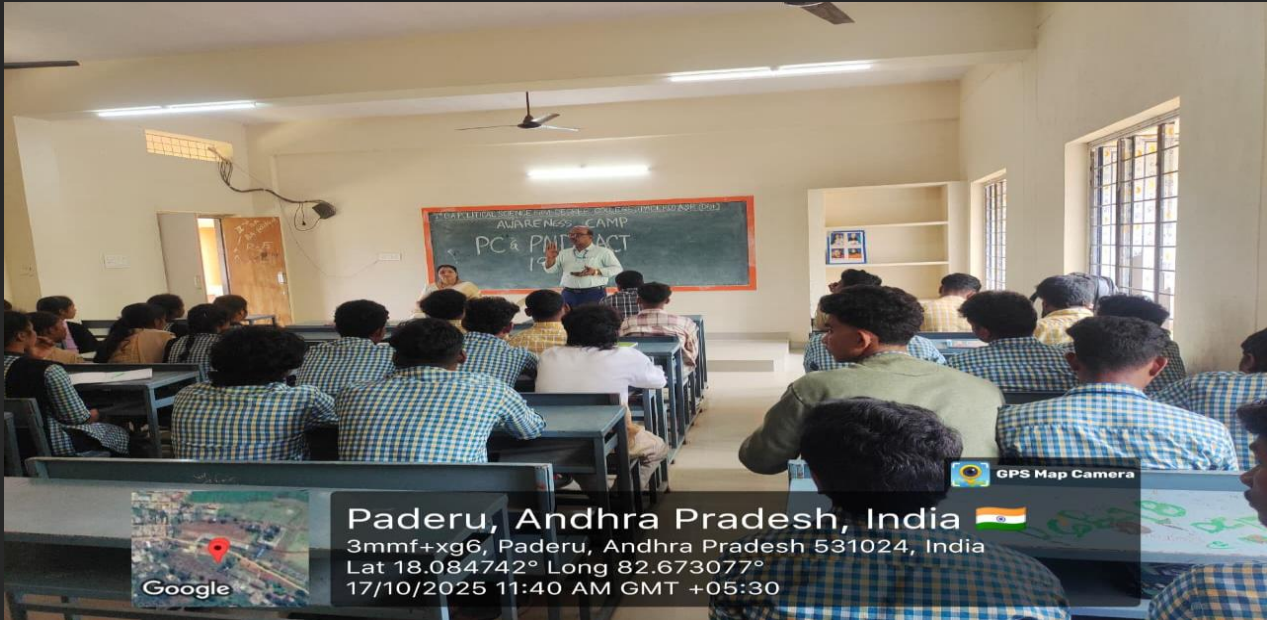
Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Birth Anniversary (15th October)
